HELPFUL TIPS

Greece is a wonderful place to visit all year round. Before you begin your trip, make sure to read our helpful travel information, to make the most of your time in Athens and beyond.

WHEN TO GO

Greece is at its liveliest during summer, from June to August, when long, sun-filled days draw visitors to its shores. Athens often exceeds 30°C, making the Mediterranean, Aegean and Ionian seas irresistible. Coastal islands buzz with energy, cooled by gentle evening breezes, though crowds are part of the experience.

For a more relaxed visit, spring (April – May) and autumn (September – November) offer warm days, cooler nights and fewer tourists. Winter is quietly charming but limited, with many islands and hotels closing between December and February.

Greek, with English widely spoken.



Time Zone
7 hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST). Daylight savings is observed from March – October.



Electricity
An international adaptor is required. Type C, low voltage 230V/50Hz.



PLAN AHEAD

- Pre-booking entrances and tours is essential to avoid disappointment, long queues and limited availability, especially during peak travel seasons.
- Book ferries and domestic flights early, especially in summer. Flights save time but ferries offer relaxed travel and scenic views.
- Taxis are available on most islands, but numbers are limited. Pre booking arrival and departure transfers is highly recommended, especially in peak season.

ITINERARY TIPS

- Pack smart with comfortable walking shoes for Athens' cobblestone streets, plus light layers for breezy island evenings.
- Eat where locals do and dine late; many restaurants don't get busy until after 8pm.
- Be flexible; island life runs slowly and that's part of the charm.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Greece must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas, and other travel requirements at [smarttraveller.gov.au](https://www.smarttraveller.gov.au)

MANDATORY TAX

Greece charges a Climate Crisis Resilience Tax. These taxes are not included in the listed "From" price as they are payable direct to your hotel on check out. Taxes vary according to the standard of accommodation and travel season, ranging from €1.50-€15 per room per night.
