WHEN TO GO

The climate varies throughout the year.

The summer months (June – August) are the most popular time to visit. The days are warmer with less rain, perfect for exploring. Dine outside under a twilight sky or enjoy some of the many exciting outdoor theatres.

In autumn (September – November), the hues begin to change as the milder weather sets in.

The winter season (December – February), sees much shorter days and cold conditions, often with rain, perfect for a warming hot chocolate at one of the many Christmas markets.

During spring (March – May), the landscape changes and the days are still warm. This is a great time to attend some of the local spring festivals.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Italy must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas, and other travel requirements for the countries you intend visiting from the Australian Government at smartraveller.gov.au.

Italy is nine hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST). Daylight Saving Time is observed from March to October where clocks are turned forward by one hour.

CURRENCY

The Euro (EUR) is used throughout Italy.

MANDATORY TAX

Most cities throughout Italy charge a city tax. City taxes are not included in the listed “From” price as they are payable direct to your hotel on checkout, and vary according to the standard of accommodation.

LANGUAGE

Italian is the official language and English is widely spoken in the major cities and tourist areas.

ROME – SPOLETO – PERUGIA – SAN GIMIGNANO – FLORENCE – ROME

Day 1: Rome to Spoleto

Depart Rome for Civita di Bagnoregio, a village perched on a rock in the middle of a lovely valley and accessed via a pedestrian bridge. Take time to explore its labyrinth of narrow alleys. Day 6: Florence to Rome (B)

Leave Florence for a journey among soft hills, velvety valleys and dense oak and chestnut woods, across the Chianti wine production area. Stop for wine tasting at Castello di Meleto. Continue towards Rome, stopping to visit the village of Cortona, enclosed in its ancient Etruscan walls. Arrive in Rome in the evening where the tour ends.

Day 4: Favara to Ragusa (B)

Next, visit Piazza Armerina's Villa Romana del Casale, which contains one of the largest collections of Roman mosaics in the world. The day ends in the magnificent hilltop town of Ragusa, home for the next two nights.

Day 5: Ragusa (B)

Start the day in indulgent style with a chocolate tasting session in Modica. The gastronomic theme continues when you venture into the countryside for a fascinating lesson in cheese-making. Learn the secrets behind creating the area's famed provola ragusana cheese and enjoy a tasting session before returning to Ragusa.
